The state of Bavaria provides families with a contribution subsidy of 100 Euro per month from September 1st of the calendar year in which a child turns three. This state grant will be offset against the monthly fees and is applicable for the entire time that a child is in daycare, until school enrolment.

- A 5 Euro monthly fee for games and drinks is charged in all groups, regardless of booking times.
- The meal fee is charged for 12 calendar months and contributions are adjusted annually.
- The minimum booking times and attendance are 4 – 5 hours per day and this must include the daily core times of 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- It may be possible to receive a grant from the Office for Young Children and Young People and Families from the city of Rosenheim. The relevant application must be submitted annually and approval of the application is income dependent.
- Breaks are essential.

We are closed for a maximum of 30 days a year. In addition, it can be closed for up to five days for further training measures. The vacation schedule will be announced in autumn.

## About us

---

We are a municipal day care institution and we were founded in 1973.

Our institution can house 89 children in four groups that comprise one standard group, one integration group (handicapped and non-handicapped children share this group, the group size is reduced in order to accommodate for this special situation), two groups with a special focus on sports and physical activity (the groups were awarded with a special certification: „Zertifizierter Bewegungskindergarten“).

In 1999 we had a special project running together with our children and their parents to find a new name for our institution. Based on the German fairy tale „Urban mouse and rural mouse“ we took the decision to name our institution „Stadtmäuse“. With this name we want to express that we aim to explore the world with our children and to help them to find new friendships. Another aspect of this name is to show the close relationship to the city of Rosenheim as our head institution.
